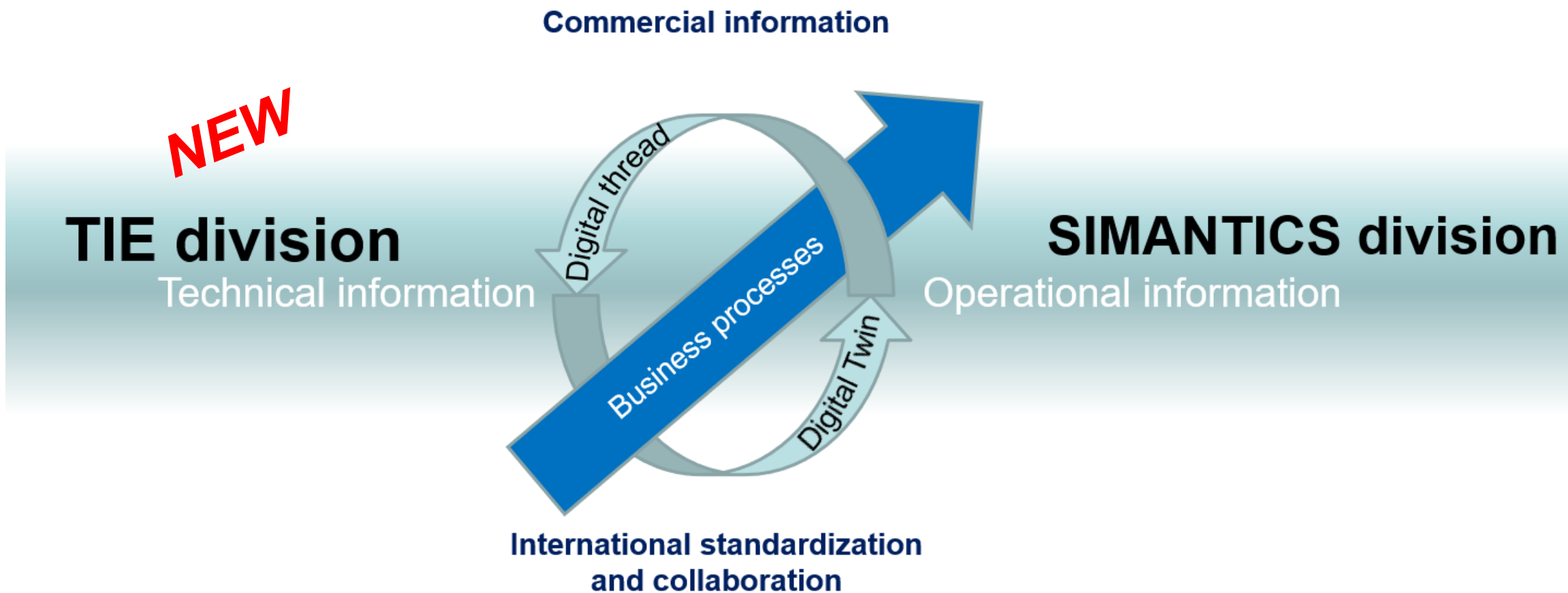

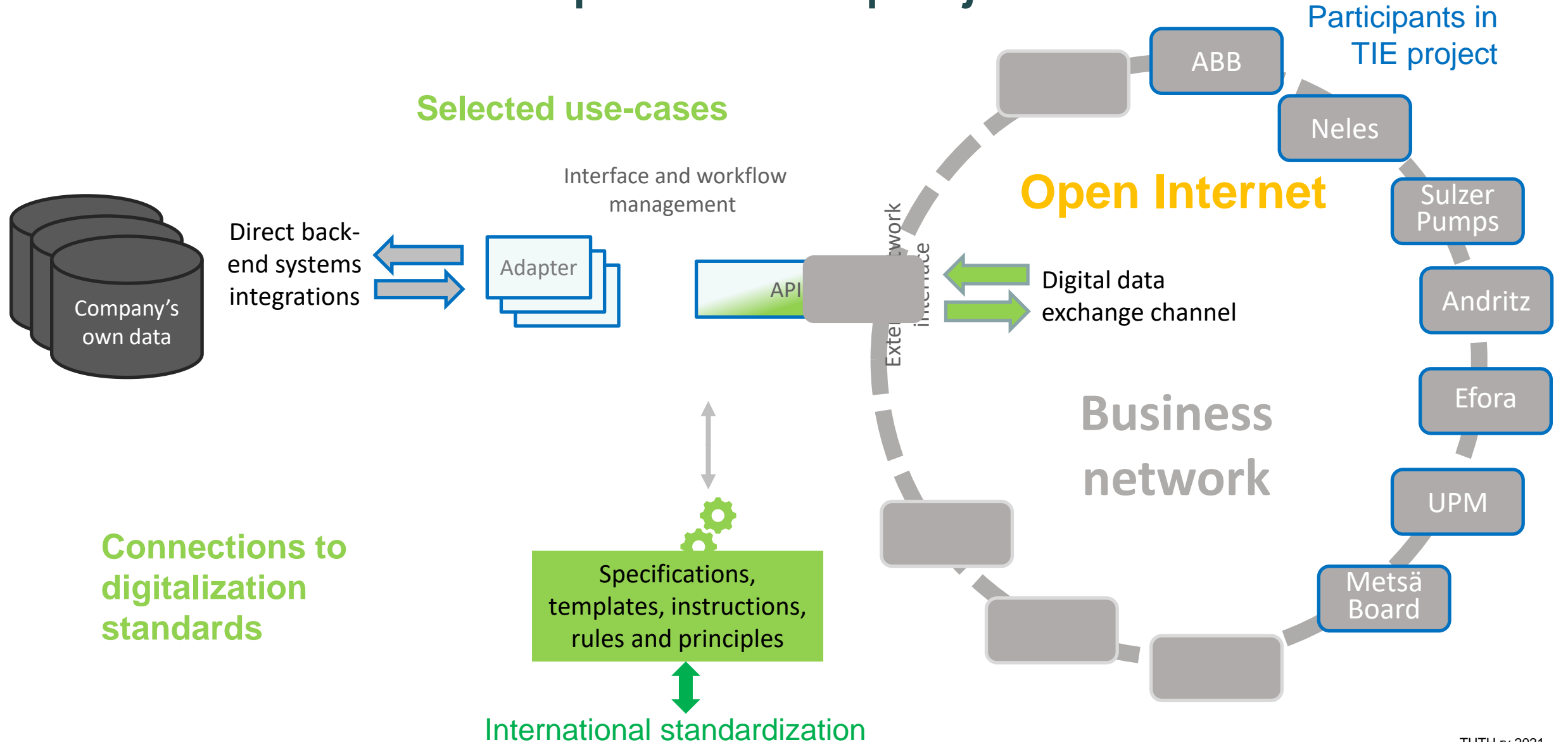


# TIE project in brief

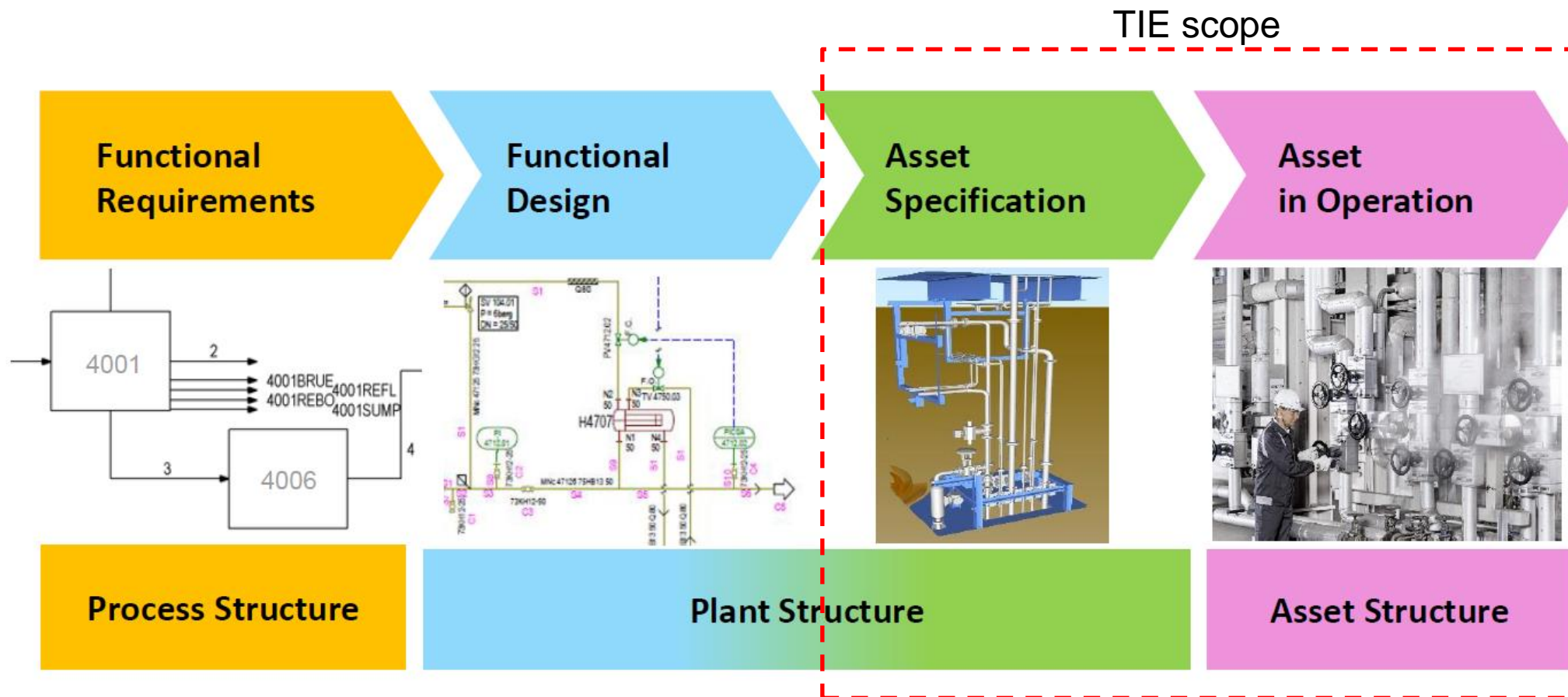
- THTH TIE started 11/2019 and will end 2/2022 (new end time)
- Targeting to define/pilot digitalization in projects and O&M based on existing standards
- How to digitalize Technical Information Exchange workflows in
  - Investment projects (equipment procurement)?
  - Spare-parts item management?
  - Replacement equipment services?
  - Energy consumption optimization?
- How to connect to standardization?
  - National and international standardization networks and collaboration

- Mission: Secure digital infrastructure for exchanging technical and business information between companies by bringing global standards and best international practices into companies interfaces

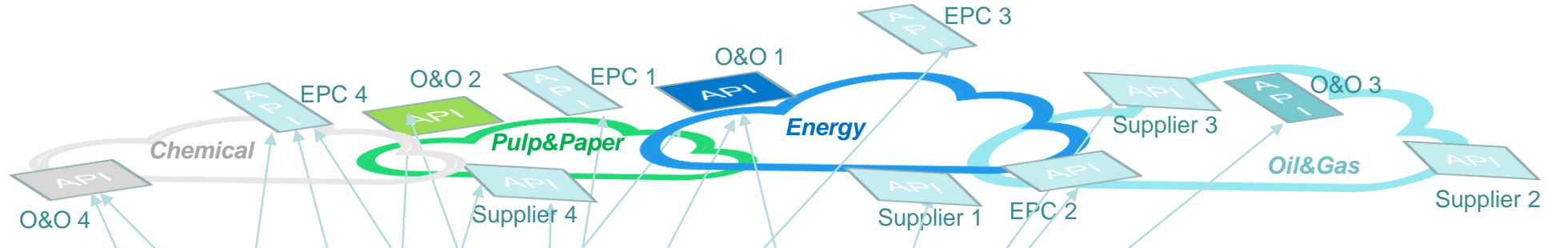
